



Expectations

As a community of Jesus Christ, we believe that it is the Holy Spirit who calls us to become members of Christ's body. We extend to each other the same love and grace given to each of us in Jesus Christ.

That said, the Confirmation journey is one we expect will be undertaken with serious intention and commitment. The following list of expectations for youth and their parents outlines what, in our experience, evidences this intentionality and commitment. Please discuss with the Youth Pastor any concerns you have regarding these expectations. Please save this list and refer back to it throughout the Confirmation journey.

Confimands

- will attend classes every week unless I am sick or away.
- will attend worship and take Communion regularly.
- will (with help) find a Covenant Partner and develop a relationship with respect and interest.
- will take part in the Confirmation Retreat October 21-23, 2011.
- will participate in service/outreach projects during the two year process.
- will create a Statement of Faith to express my honest and personal faith. I will share this with the Session of the Church as a part of the examination on May 15, 2013.
- to celebrate Confirmation, I will participate in the worship service and lunch celebration on May 19, 2013.
- will maintain open communication with Youth Pastor about concerns or questions.

Parents/Guardians

- will pray with and for my child.
- will attend worship and take Communion regularly.
- will attend adult "Walk With Me" class every week unless I am sick or away.
- will encourage my child to be involved in the activities of the church community.
- will make the Confirmation journey a priority in our family's activities.
- will gather with other parents in the months before May 19, 2013 to dream up and share tasks for preparing a wonderful Confirmation Sunday.
